## Prajay Tipre Receives Gordon A. Vreeland Award at American Legion Jersey Boys State

Prajay Tipre of Princeton, NJ Awarded "Best Delegate" Annual Scholarship at 68th Session of Program

LAWRENCEVILLE, NJ – On Friday, the American Legion Jersey Boys State (ALJBS) announced Prajay Tipre of Princeton, NJ, as the recipient of the Gordon A. Vreeland Best Delegate award for 68<sup>th</sup> session of American Legion Jersey Boys State. Tipre, who was actively involved in the program, was also elected Lieutenant Governor of Jersey Boys State.

Since 2009, Jersey Boys State has honored one statesmen each session who best exemplifies dedication and achievement in the program. Tipre, sponsored by American Legion Post #148, receives a \$1,000 scholarship to aid his college education. Each senior counselor of ALJBS' eighteen cities submitted one candidate whose record was reviewed and later interviewed by the ALJBS Senior Honors Committee.

Gordon A. Vreeland has the distinction of being the longest serving Jersey Boys State staff member at 54 years. Vreeland has returned to volunteer every year since he was a statesman in 1959.

"We're very proud and excited of Lieutenant Governor Prajay Tipre and his accomplishments during Jersey Boys State," said David Bagatelle, Director of American Legion Jersey Boys State. "This scholarship is designed to both recognize an exemplary statesmen and aid his college education each year."
