American Legion Jersey Boys State's 69th Session to be held June 22-27, 2013 Nearly 1,000 Students from New Jersey Schools to attend "A Week That Shapes the Future"

TRENTON, NJ -- American Legion Jersey Boys State (ALJBS) will hold its 69th week-long, college-level program with nearly 1,000 expected statesmen in attendance from June 22, to June 27, 2014. The program is sponsored by the American Legion Department of New Jersey and will be held at Rider University in Lawrenceville, N.J.

Top of the class students from more than 325 New Jersey communities will participate in ALJBS' hands-on approach to government in action at the local, county and state level. Within 24 hours of their arrival to ALJBS, each city will have divided into political parties and elected a mayor and council from within their ranks. By the end of the week, the delegation will have elected a new ALJBS Governor, Lieutenant Governor and two Boys Nation Senators who will attend a national program in Washington, D.C. this summer.

"In its 69th year, Jersey Boys State will continue to be one of the nation's most respected and revered leadership programs of its kind," said David Bagatelle, Director of American Legion Jersey Boys State. "The all-volunteer staff at Jersey Boys State is excited to welcome 1,000 statesmen to this year's session."

Highlights include:

- Notable speakers including Senator Robert Menendez, Congressman Leonard Lance, US Senate candidate Jeffrey Bell, former Congressman Bob Inglis (SC), among many others;
- A college fair featuring nearly 100 institutions from across the country;
- Leadership and career seminars featuring business executives, military representatives, political consultants, law experts and journalists, among other professional experts;
- Election of a the 69th ALJBS Governor on Thursday, June 26; and
- Election of two Boys Nation Senators on Friday June 27, who will represent New Jersey at the annual American Legion Boys Nation program in Washington D.C., from July 18-26, 2014.

Notable ALJBS alumni include Governor Christopher Christie (Boys Nation Senator, 1979), Senator Robert Menendez (1971), Senator Cory Booker (1986), Supreme Court Justice Samuel Alito (1967), Congressman Leonard Lance (1969) and Assemblyman Herbert Conaway (ALJBS Governor, 1980).
